Implementation and Strict Adherence to NCAHP Guidelines including Approved Subjects/Disciplines

In pursuance of the provisions laid down by the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Professions (NCAHP) vide file no Z-1011/2026/NCAHP(AHS)/UGC/FTS No. 8384323 dated 09.01.2026 and in alignment with the regulatory framework governing Allied and Healthcare education, it is hereby notified that all affiliated institutions under the West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS) shall strictly adhere to the guidelines, norms, standards, and approved disciplines/subjects as prescribed by NCAHP from time to time as enclosed herewith. The resolutions taken in the meetings of the corresponding Board of Studies approved the following changes in nomenclature of the courses being taught in the different institutions affiliated to the WBUHS.

All institutions must ensure:

1. Compliance with curriculum structure, duration, and academic standards as prescribed by NCAHP.
2. Maintenance of requisite infrastructure, faculty strength, and clinical facilities in accordance with NCAHP norms.
3. Adherence to eligibility criteria, admission procedures, and training requirements as stipulated by NCAHP.
4. No introduction, continuation, or modification of any course/subject outside the purview of NCAHP without prior approval of the University and competent authority.
5. Implementation of all regulatory updates, amendments, and advisories issued by NCAHP without deviation.

The Institutions are hereby invited to apply for increased intake in the above courses and in the corresponding Post Graduate courses to cater to the needs of human resource required to run the Under Graduate courses. They are also instructed to follow the guidelines of NCAHP if they want to apply for any new course as enlisted in the website of NCAHP.

Non-compliance with the above guidelines and prescribed disciplines shall be viewed seriously and may invite appropriate action as per University Statutes and applicable regulatory provisions.

This notification shall come into force with immediate effect and shall be binding on all affiliated colleges/institutions offering Allied and Healthcare courses under WBUHS.

This notification has been issued as per decision taken by competent authority of Swasthya Bhawan, Govt. of West Bengal and the WBUHS.
